Dear Friends and Family,

We had a great month of April. We were blessed to see the Lord working in our lives. As many of you know, we have spent a lot of time looking for a new house. We couldn't continue renting the apartment we had at the beginning because of the space and the 5th floor. It would not work for church services. We went to look at several different houses in different areas of the city. Then, one opened up midway through April for us to check out. When we got there, we realized we were right in the middle of the city, in a great neighborhood, right on a main route, but not too crowded either. The house needs some work, but it is big enough for us to live in and have services in. There is a storefront for rent right next to us that we would love to rent in the future for the church.

We have begun attending a church that was started a year ago by a national missionary, Bro. Juan Duarte. It is called Iglesia Bautista La Verdad. Since we have not yet begun services in our house, we have started attending there. We have begun to have a great relationship with them. They are sent out of their home church in Rionegro, Colombia. We have started helping them with some of their activities. They had an evangelistic conference from the 10th to the 12th of April. His pastor, Bro. Peter Putney, an American missionary in Colombia, came to preach, and we were able to have some good fellowship with them as well. We helped with some special music and got the chance to lead a lady and a child to the Lord after one of the invitations. They also gave me the opportunity to preach on Sunday, the 26th. We are glad to serve and help, but we are also excited to see what the Lord will do here as we get things started.



On another good note, my visa got approved for the next year. Now, we are just waiting for the rest of the family's visas to get approved as beneficiaries. All the paperwork is put in, so we are just waiting for them to approve it. It ended up being a little more expensive than we thought, but God provides. Also, Tirsia Shields, a young lady who grew up with my wife as her "aunt," has come to stay with us for three months. We are excited to have her here with us, and she has already been a big help with kids' classes and different things. So far, the Lord has given us much to get things going here, and we are excited to see what He has for us in the future. Speaking of the future, we still have a lot to get done. We plan to get some chairs, a speaker, wood to make a pulpit, and a few other things to prepare for services here. We want to start inviting kids from the surrounding neighborhood to a kids' club on Saturdays. One of the needs we have right now that you can help us pray for is for a vehicle. We have sold our van in the States, but we still do not have enough money for a good, reliable vehicle here yet. We know that God will take care of all of these things and many more needs we have right now. Especially since we have all of you faithful prayer warriors on our side, praying with us. You have helped us pray for Claudia's citizenship, our visas for here, for us to get here to Colombia, and many other important things, and we have seen God answer them all. Thank you very much for praying for us.

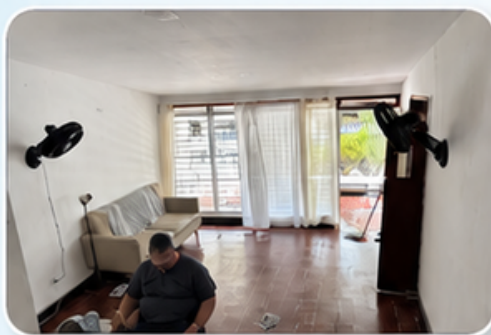
